GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Following the Health and Local Government Ministerial Statement given earlier in the week, kindly note that this Sabbath (20th January, 2018), Churches IN and AROUND Garden and Chipata areas shall not gather for worship. As for the rest of Lusaka under Midlands Zambia territory, and all other districts in the Conference, services may go up to midday (Main Service) with strict adherence to hygiene (NO CARRYING OF FOOD, NO HANDSHAKES AND PLEASE CARRY SANITISERS). Our Conference (Midlands Zambia Conference) shall continue giving us weekly updates over this matter. ***Please note that our area is out of the catchment that will continue under the extension of the temporary suspension of worship gatherings***. **OVERCROWDING IS OF PARTICULAR CONCERN AND THEREFORE NOTE THAT THIS PROVISION IS ONLY FOR REGULAR WORSHIPERS AT UNIVERSITY CHURCH TO THE MOST PRACTICAL EXTENT POSSIBLE SO THAT WE REMAIN WITHIN THE GUIDELINES OF MINISTRY OF HEALTH.** Let us all continue praying for God's intervention.
- Due to the Cholera situation in Lusaka all Residential Fellowship Band prayer meetings have been suspended until further notice. Families are encouraged to hold prayer sessions in their homes on Wednesdays and Fridays. Respective Residential Fellowship Band leadership are requested to frequently update their members with study materials, topics etc via your Band WhatsApp platforms.

HEALTH TIP

Cholera-

Is an infectious disease caused by *Vibrio Cholerae*. It is spread by contaminated water, food with human stool. The incubation period ranges from 2hours to 5days. The signs and symptoms include diarrhoea, vomiting, muscle cramps, sunken eyes and severe dehydration. The risk factors are poor sanitation, not having clean drinking water, and poverty. Children are a risk group and those who have low immunity as well as those with reduced gastric acid.

- Parents and guardians to escort their children to the conveniences/ washrooms/ toilets at all times to ensure maximum hygiene.
- Parents or guardians should not let the children crawl in Church or any public place during this cholera epidemic

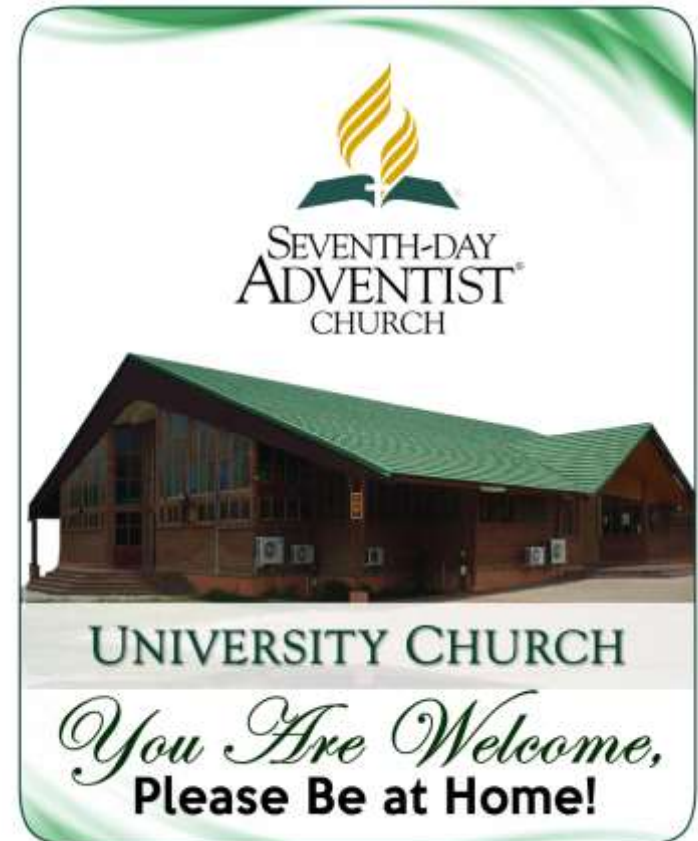
